

**ADDITIONAL KAUAI REQUIREMENTS**

- 1) All productions filming on the Island of Kauai MUST register with the film office and sign and return the State of Hawaii Guidelines and turn in a COVID Safety Plan to the Kauai Film Office. When forming a COVID Safety Plan, the Production will review the Safe Way Forward document and follow it to the extent possible.
  
- 2) The State guidelines are the MINIMUM guidelines required for productions in Hawaii. Production companies may require stricter protocols, such as testing and temperature monitoring. Kauai recommends that all productions review the Safe Way Forward document prior to start of production.
  
- 3) If a cast or crew member does test positive, that person is put into immediate self-quarantine for ten days (or until released by a physician), and a second test will be run to confirm or refute the diagnosis. In the event of a discordant result, a third test will be run and the decision on how to proceed will be made by the Production. Contact tracing will be employed to identify the source of infection and any close contacts within the production. The Kauai District Department of Health office should (808-241-3495) as well as the Kauai Film Commission (808-241-4953) should be informed to minimize transmission in the world outside the production.
